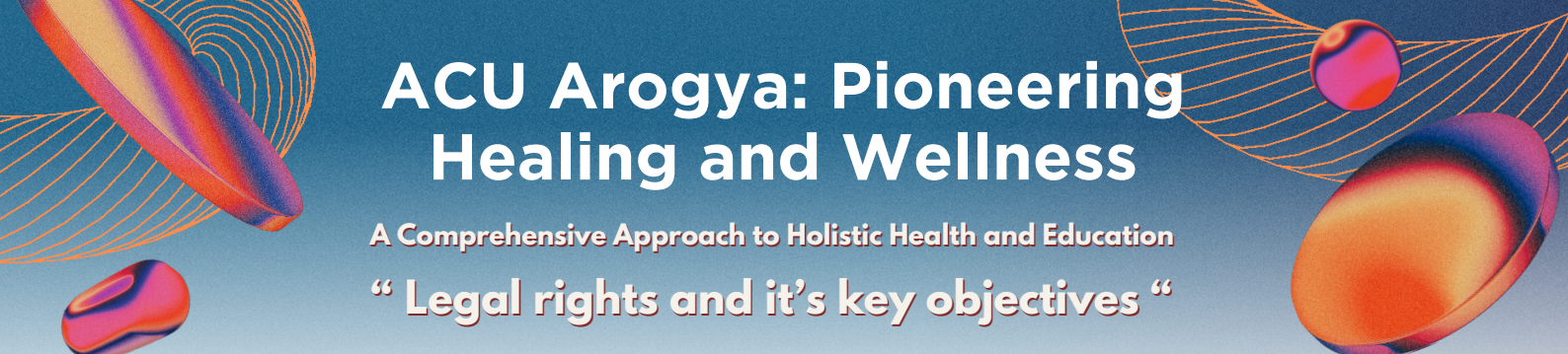

 - The NGO can independently own property, open bank accounts, enter contracts, and sue or be sued.
2. **Receive Donations**
 - Authorized to receive donations, contributions, grants, funding, and institutional support.
3. **Own Assets**
 - Can purchase land, lease property, acquire buildings, buy vehicles, own equipment, and hold intellectual property.
4. **Operate Across India**
 - The MOA authorizes nationwide operations, not limiting the NGO to Telangana.
5. **Employ Staff and Experts**
 - Can hire and remunerate doctors, researchers, trainers, teachers, consultants, and administrative staff.
6. **Establish Institutions**
 - Empowered to establish hospitals, clinics, health centers, research centers, schools, and skill-development institutes, subject to necessary approvals.
7. **Limited Liability Protection**
 - Members and directors generally enjoy limited liability protection under the company structure.
8. **Eligibility for Tax Exemptions**
 - Upon obtaining registrations like 12A and 80G, the NGO can benefit from income-tax exemptions, allowing donors to claim deductions.

Legal Restrictions

- **Distribute Profits:** No dividends or profits can be distributed to members; all income must be used for the NGO's objectives.
- **Use Funds for Personal Benefit:** Funds are strictly for approved charitable activities.
- **Change Objects Freely:** Modifications to the MOA/AOA require regulatory approval.
